OCII partners with the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) to implement our workforce program. OEWD job training programs include:

- **CityBuild Academy** offers San Francisco residents training and placement in 26 construction trades. The **Construction Administration & Professional Services Academy** provides practical administrative training.
- OEWD also offers trainings in several non-construction industries such as **Health Care, Hospitality and Technology**.

 - 1,563 San Francisco residents worked on OCII projects
 - 594 Bayview Hunters Point residents worked on OCII projects, yielding \$12,892,470 in wages
