Project Background

- Identified as a top priority in the Bayview Community-Based Transportation Plan (2020)
- Recipient of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) Sustainable Transportation Equity Projects grant
 - Received \$10.5M in grant funding
- Pilot project with an end date of March 2026
- Identified six goals:
 - Improve community mobility
 - Improve community health and reduce emissions
 - Invest in the community and create jobs
 - Connect residents and transportation services
 - Support and supplement existing transit services

Project Committees



Community Congress

15-person body that acts as the oversight board for the project led by BVHPCA



Outreach

Group focused on outreach that includes CYC, HPF, MNC, One Bayview, and SFAACD



Transportation Resource Center

Led by CYC and supported by BACR to act as a community hub and resource for transportation-related questions



Workforce Development

Led by APRI and supported by YCD to recruit, train, and hire local drivers


Service Zone

Bayview Shuttle is an on-demand corner-to-corner public rideshare service that takes you around Bayview and Hunters Point, and connects you to Muni, key transit hubs for BART and Caltrain, and SF General Hospital.

How it Works



Book a ride and get picked up in a branded vehicle with other passengers headed in the same direction as you.

The service is corner-to-corner which means that you'll be picked up a short walk from your origin location

Wheelchair accessible vehicles are available, offering door-to-door service for riders with limited mobility

Service Hours

Monday - Friday
7:00AM - 7:00PM

Saturday - Sunday
10:00AM - 6:00PM

Ride Fares

\$2.75 per rider
\$1.35 per rider (Discounted programs)

Youth ages 18 and under ride for FREE

Payment Methods

Clipper (Reloadable card, physical or digital)
MuniMobile app (digital ticket)
Lifeline Monthly Pass for those eligible



Performance Updates




Other Key Metrics:

- Met 97% of ride requests
- 10 min. avg. pickup ETAs
- 4.9 average ride rating
- 175 riders completed 5+ bookings
- 1> ETA deviation from estimated pickup time

Other Impacts

Employment Impacts

- Bayview Shuttle creates jobs directly - **60% of Via's drivers live in the Bayview + Hunter's Point**
- Bayview Shuttle offers access to an additional **16,000 jobs** within 30 minutes of their residence

Environmental Impacts

- Via vehicles have traveled 11,450+ miles, contributing to **4 tons of CO2 reduction** compared to the same mileage covered by private, gas-powered vehicles
- **20%** of Bayview Shuttle riders use the service instead of a private vehicle
- **44%** of riders are using the Bayview shuttle to connect to/from public transportation
